Rules and Entry Information

March 27, 2010

Due to the limited number of participants allowed, pre-entry is available for all events except the kids calf scramble. Pre-entry is highly encouraged for the stockdog competition to ensure a spot. No refunds will be given for no-shows. There is a buckle and \$1,000 added money in the Herman Daugherty memorial working cow horse competition sponsored by Pine Creek Cattle Company, however, to be eligible; the same horse must be used in the 3-man calf branding.

You must either be or work full time for a Tehama County Cattlemen's Association and a California Cattlemen's Association member to participate. Memberships can be turned in at the field day or mailed with pre-entry forms.

Schedule of Events

9:00 AM Stockdog contestant registration

9:30 AM Stockdog trial - \$50 entry

11:30 AM Afternoon event and lunch registration

1:30 PM Afternoon events

Stockman’s challenge - \$25 a man entry

2-man teams move through an obstacle course – fastest time wins

Working cow horse - \$25 entry

\$1,000 added and buckle from Pine Creek Cattle Company

Horse must compete in the calf branding to be eligible

3-man calf branding - \$25 a man entry

Stockdog Competition Rules

To be in the stockdog competition you must be a Tehama County Cattlemen's member or a full time employee of a member. Memberships are available. Entry fee is \$50/dog. There is a limit of 15 participants

- All contestant must be mounted on horseback
- Judges will describe trial course and criteria for judging at the handler meeting to be held before the trial
- Any mishandling of stock will result in a no-time at the judges discretion
- All dogs welcome

Working Cow Horse Rules

To qualify for the Herman Daugherty buckle and \$1,000 added money your horse must be in the working cow horse and branding competitions. To be in the working cow horse competition you must be a Tehama County Cattlemen's member or a full time employee of a member. No limit on entries. Memberships are available. Entries are \$25/person

- One animal will be turned into the corral and you must work the first calf.
- Horse and rider must box the cow at the same end of corral to show horse's cow sense.
- Contestant will then allow cow to run at least 2/3 length of corral (long end). Make one good turn each way on the fence.
- Contestants will then circle calf in either direction to demonstrate control
- Rider and/or judges can call time.
- Judges rulings are final

3-man, 3-calf Branding Rules

To qualify for the Herman Daugherty buckle your horse must be in the branding. To be in the 3-man branding you must be a Tehama County Cattlemen's member or a full time employee of a member. Memberships are available. Entries are \$25/person or \$75/team. Limited to 15 teams

A team with all three members in contention for the buckle (i.e. in all events) may use three horses, but let the judges know

(All violations result in a 30-second penalty)

- ❖ Each team will brand 3 calves, with 3 people, 2 horses on each team
- ❖ Can enter more than once, but must change 2 members of team
- ❖ Time starts when ropers are ready
- ❖ All 3 team members must head, heel and be on the ground at least once
- ❖ Cannot break a trot until after the calf is roped
- ❖ Neck, and neck with one front foot, are only legal head catches
- ❖ Member on the ground may assist with illegal catches or hang-ups, but calf must be re-roped
- ❖ Cannot heel the calf until it is legally headed (one or two hind feet heeled is ok)
- ❖ All four feet must remain in stretched ropes while the brand is placed
- ❖ Calf cannot be lifted off the ground while being stretched (i.e. do not stretch calf so tight as to pull it off the ground)
- ❖ Brand must be placed correctly
- ❖ Time is called when iron is returned to bucket after the last calf is branded
- ❖ 5 minute time limit
- ❖ Cattle are luck of the draw

Stockman's Challenge Rules

You do not have to compete in the stockman's challenge to qualify for the Herman Daugherty buckle and \$1,000 added. To be in the stockman's challenge competition you must be a Tehama County Cattlemen's member or a full time employee of a member. Memberships are available. Entries are \$25/person or \$50/team

- Cattle will be turned into the end of the pen.
- Time starts when riders advance towards cattle.
- Two man teams of horse and rider must complete the course within the time limit in order to receive a time.
- Judges will determine the time limit.
- Fastest time to complete the course wins.
- Judges can end the run at their discretion if handlers get the cattle to worked up.
- Contestants time ends when the last animal crosses through the last obstacle
- Judges rulings are final

Kid's Calf Scramble Rules

Parents of calf scramble participants must be Tehama County Cattlemen's members. There is no entry fee for the calf scramble. There will be junior and senior division awards.

- If participants are in eighth grade or lower then they are composed of two man teams
- If participants are over eighth grade then team consists of one participant.
- Participants will put a halter on a calf and drag it to a central designated area
- First junior and senior teams to get a haltered calf to the designated area wins
